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Q Will my children be able use the vending machines/shop on site?

A Yes, they will be allowed to use the machines or the shop during the lunchtime break. A limit of £2 per child is allowed. If they require a snack during the other breaks please ensure you send along something for the snack.

Q Do I need to provide a drink for my child?

A No, children will be required to bring a bottle with their name on and the name of the centre. We will refill all bottles during the duration of the day. If this is not possible we sell water bottles at reception.

Q Where does my child go to at the start of the day?

A Your child should report to main reception on arrival and then will be directed to the registration point to register and order lunch if required.

Q If requested, will my child be able to leave the facility

A Yes, all children are to remain in the facility throughout the session unless parents have requested in writing. Children under 8 will not be allowed to leave the session.

Q Does the person who dropped off my child need to collect them also?

A No. However, all children must be collected by a parent or guardian, unless provided with written confirmation of other arrangements. Passwords must be given.

Q What if my child wants to leave a session or activity? Can they do that?

A No, children are not to leave the session or activity they are taking part in (including lunchtime) without seeking permission from a member of staff.

Q What should my child do if they have any problems during the session?

A They should speak to a member of staff straightaway.

Q For venues with Swimming Pools do I need to provide a swimming costume?

A Yes, children on the 8-13 camp will be required to bring their swimming costumes and a towel. 6-8 year old children will not require these items.

Q Will there be anywhere to store valuables such as mobile phones?

A The venue cannot accept any responsibility for personal belongings or valuable items. If it is valuable, please do not bring it.

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HOLIDAY CAMP - CODE OF CONDUCT

- PLEASE NOTE CHILDREN WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO USE THE VENDING MACHINES AT LUNCH TIME, IF CHILDREN REQUIRE A SNACK DURING BREAKS PLEASE ENSURE YOU SEND ALONG SOMETHING FOR SNACK. BREAKFAST OPTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE DURING REGISTRATION AS WELL AS LUNCH OPTIONS.
- If any child is breaks any of the Holiday Camp rules, is found to be bullying teasing or making any kind of obscene references towards any other child or staff member, they will be subject to the SIV Behaviour Management procedure as follows:-

Strike 1 –The young person will be removed from the group activity and spoken to about their behaviour until a resolution has been reached and they feel ready to rejoin the session. Parents will be informed of the 1st strike on collection of their son/daughter. This will be recorded in the behaviour diary.

Strike 2 – The young person will be taken to a quiet space in the room and informed that their parents will be contacted. The young person should be advised that if they continue to demonstrate unacceptable behaviour they will be excluded. This should be recorded in the behaviour diary.

Strike 3 – The young person will be removed from the holiday club and parents contacted via emergency contact number and advised that their son/daughter has been excluded from the holiday camp and requested to collect them immediately. Once the young person has reached a 3rd strike in a single holiday camp they will be excluded for the remainder of that week but will be permitted to attend the following week with a clean sheet.

- All children should report to main reception on arrival and then to the holiday club staff where they will register and order lunch etc unless otherwise informed.
- All children to remain in the facility throughout each session
- All children must be collected by a parent or guardian, unless provided with written confirmation of other arrangements.
- No children to enter restricted areas such as store rooms or offices etc. without permission from Holiday club staff.
- Children are not to leave the session or activity they are taking part in (including lunchtime)
- If a child has any problems during the sessions, they should speak to holiday club staff.
- Under no circumstances should any child use any equipment if not supervised by a qualified instructor
- Holiday club staff cannot accept any responsibility for personal belongings or valuable items e.g. money or mobile phones etc. If it is valuable, please do not bring it.

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
